

SHOT RECORDING INSTRUCTIONS

TO ENSURE VALID ATTEMPTS ARE COMPLETED, OUTLINED INSTRUCTIONS BELOW MUST BE FOLLOWED.

STEP 1: Make sure golfer, target (pin), and hitting area markers (tee marker, sign, flag, etc.) are in frame. This viewing angle will position the recording device “down the line” of the shot directly behind the golfer with the target line centered.

STEP 2: Begin recording prior to the first golfer’s attempt. The viewing angle and position should be the same for each golfer. If a ball is presumed to have been holed, **DO NOT STOP THE RECORDING** after the attempts have completed.

STEP 3: With the recording remaining on, approach the green. Make sure the recording is pointed toward the target (pin) at all times. It is important there are no breaks in the recording or loss in line-of-sight with the target (pin).

STEP 4: Walk to the target (pin) and display the ball that was holed inside the cup. Recording may be in vertical or horizontal format and sent to the Event Director/Main Contact, along with the winning golfer’s name, email, and phone number.
